Activities

In 2005, HOIM's founder and supporters began conducting annual mission trips to Cameroon, ministering at orphanages, prisons and higher education campuses, and organizing seminars and conferences for local church and ministry leaders. HOIM also created the **Solomon Nfor Gwei Awards** to provide general operating support and ministerial scholarships to pastors and ministry leaders serving on the frontlines in Cameroon.

As the Lord allows, our long term plans include the construction of a Retreat and Resource Center in Cameroon, additional yearly mission trips, sustained support for 3 orphanages run by our partners, and sponsorship for people who need

Statement of Faith

- **O** We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative Word of God.
- **O** We believe that there is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
